Guidelines and Criteria:

- Must be a high school senior, and either be a current Nymeo member or attend a high school located in Frederick or Montgomery County. A GPA of 3.0 or higher is required.
- Applications are evaluated on academic achievement, community service and written or video essay.
- Winners will be contacted in May from Nymeo.

Application Materials Required:

- Completed scholarship application.
- High school transcript with overall cumulative GPA.
- Resume highlighting past accomplishments, community service and other experiences.
- Essay (500 words or less) *OR* a video essay (no longer than 3 minutes) addressing the following theme:

"An effort made for the happiness of others lifts above ourselves".
